- Engaging in adultery is as dangerous as taking fire in your bosom or walking on hot coals; you will be burned and scorched.
- The one who goes into his neighbor's wife will not go unpunished.
- While theft to satisfy hunger may be understood and the thief must repay sevenfold, the one who commits adultery lacks sense and destroys himself.
- Adultery brings wounds and disgrace, and the reproach will not be blotted out.
- Jealousy enrages a man, and he will not spare in the day of vengeance.
- No amount of ransom or gifts will satisfy the wronged husband.
